### REMOVE DEBRIS

**to improve safety and access  
to other areas for cleanup**

- 900 tires
- 55 cubic yards wood debris
- 38,700 pounds scrap metal
- 6 structures
- Various appliances, campers, boats, furniture, and more

### REMOVE ASBESTOS

**to allow components to be  
salvaged or reused**

### CLEANUP SOILS

**to make suitable for public use**

- asbestos
- arsenic
- lead
- PCBs
